Installment payments are available; you will be required to pay a deposit at the time of registration and the remaining amount owing is divided equally into 3 monthly installments based on the date that you registered (ie: if you register June 16, payments will be July 16, Aug 16 and Sept 16).

Registration will be denied for players who have outstanding balances from previous seasons. For those players, outstanding balances for previous seasons plus payment for the current season must be made IN FULL before the player is permitted on the ice.

2024/2025 SEASON HOW TO REGISTER

- HOCKEY CANADA ID: You will not be able to register without your players Hockey Canada ID#. Click on this link for a "how to" on locating your Hockey Canada ID#: Locating your Hockey Canada ID
- SET UP YOUR SPORTLE ACCOUNT: Set up your Hockey Canada Sportle account to: access your Hockey Canada ID, update your contact information, view your coaching credentials, see your team history. Click the link to create your HC Sportle account <u>CREATE A SPORTLE ACCOUNT</u>
- PAY OFFLINE OPTION: If you select the "pay offline" option at registration checkout, etransfer (to: <u>treasurer@wolverineshockey.ca</u>) must be received within 7 days of registration or your registration will be considered incomplete. If you require a payment plan you must contact <u>info@wolverineshockey.ca</u> to make arrangements.
- EMAIL ADDRESS: The email address that you list as the players email will be used as our main point of contact email for your family. All communication will be sent to this email address. Please do not use an address that isn't monitored daily.
- RESPECT IN SPORT: Parents must complete the "Respect in Sport Parent Edition (RIS)" online course before you can register online with Wolverines. The fee for this course is \$12.00. Choose "Wolverines Hockey Club" as your hockey association. The course is valid for 4 years. Families that do not have this course will be unable to register online. The Respect in Sport – Parent Edition can be found here: <u>RESPECT IN SPORT FOR PARENTS</u>
- HOCKEY CANADA POSITION: You will be asked to select your player's position. Select either forward, defence or goalie (required for U11 to U21 only).
- HYBRID GOALIE: This is a position being offered to U11 players only. Details can be found here: <u>HYBRID</u> GOALIE PROGRAM. U11 players can select hybrid goalie at registration.
- FOR PLAYERS TRYING OUT FOR ELITE HOCKEY (BUFFALOES/NORTHSTARS/GHC): Players trying out for elite hockey are REQUIRED to register with Wolverines as well. If you do not register with Wolverines, we can not guarantee that a spot will be held for the player. During the registration process, select <u>YES</u> in response to the quadrant question at checkout. You will be required to pay a \$500.00 registration fee deposit at the time of registration. This deposit is fully refunded should the player secure an AA or AAA spot. If the player returns to play for Wolverines, the deposit is applied to their registration. The reminder of the player registration fees is due once the player has been notified of team placement with WHC. The deposit will be surrendered to WHC should the player quit after being placed on a WHC team, in accordance with the WHC Refund and Withdrawal policy.

> **PLAYERS NEEDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE**:

- FLAMES EVEN STRENGTH PROGRAM: The Flames Even Strength Program (FESP) is administered through Hockey Calgary. The FESP online application can be found here: <u>https://www.hockeycalgary.ca/registration/flames-even-strength-program</u>. If you are applying for FESP, forward your notice of approval to: <u>info@wolverineshockey.ca</u> and the full subsidy amount (\$700 for community hockey, \$700 for House League) will be subtracted from your fees. The remaining balance can be paid in installments.
- <u>WOLVERINES HOCKEY PLAYER ASSISTANCE FUND:</u> The Wolverines Hockey Club Player Assistance Fund assists Wolverines families who are experiencing financial hardship. The Player Assistance Fund is available to help with registration fees and/or cash calls. Families interested in receiving funding through the Player Assistance Fund are asked to complete an application to determine eligibility. - MEDICAL FORM: The player medical form is to be completed at the time of registration and uploaded into your player profile. You can not register until this step is completed. Medical forms are kept confidential and can only be seen by the Manager of Operations, the Team Manager and the Head Coach. 2 options for uploading your players medical form:
 - Complete the fillable PDF online, SAVE it to your computer and UPLOAD the saved document.
 - Print off the PDF, fill it out and UPLOAD either a scan or picture of the document.
- WAIVERS: Wolverines and Hockey Calgary waivers, acknowledgment of policies and consent will be required during the registration process and will need a digital signature; the system will prompt you to type a name it is expecting – copy it exactly.
- VOLUNTEER BOND: *NEW THIS YEAR*: The purpose of the Wolverines Volunteer Bond Program is to encourage all Club members to become actively involved in the operation and success of the Club. The volunteer bond will be in place for the 2024/2025 season. Details will be sent out prior to the start of the season.
- REFUND & WITHDRAWAL POLICY: The refund policy is outlined in the Standing Policies and Procedures document which is available on our website. Refunds for hockey registration are available from WHC when a player withdraws for the season. No refunds will be issued for missed games or portions of the season. The jersey levy is non-refundable. To initiate a withdrawal, parents need to email the Treasurer at treasurer@Wolverineshockey.ca

Refunds will be issued as follows:

- Prior to the player's first assigned evaluation ice time (or conditioning skate if applicable) 100% minus a \$50 Admin fee and \$25 jersey levy
- Prior to being notified of team placement 50% minus a \$50 Admin fee and \$25 jersey levy
- No refunds will be provided after teams have been formed except for withdrawal due to medical reason or family relocation out of zone 9

In such cases, refunds will be pro-rated. Medical withdrawal requirements are outlined below:

- > Medical certificate (on medical practice letterhead)
- Date of diagnosis
- Medical reason/recommendation for non-participation
- > Printed name and signature of medical professional
- > The refund will be prorated based on the date of diagnosis

Once a medical refund has been given, the player will be removed from the official roster and will no longer be allowed to participate in team activities. The roster spot will now be considered vacant and could be filled by a new player registration.

No refunds will be issued for suspended players.

Notice of withdrawals will only be accepted via email to the Manager of Operations at <u>info@wolverineshockey.ca</u>. The date and time stamp of the email will be used to determine eligibility and what refund scenario is applicable.

PLAYERS NEW TO HOCKEY

Registration for hockey is a 3 step process:

1) Complete the Respect in Sport for Parents online course

- <u>https://www.hockeycalgary.ca/registration/certification/parent</u>. This course costs \$12, takes about an hour to complete and is valid for 4 years. Please be sure to select WOLVERINES HOCKEY CLUB as the association (not Calgary). Once you've completed the course, a Hockey Canada ID will be issued to your player. You will need this number to register.

2) Complete the Wolverines online registration form (links are above)

3) Send your players proof of residency (Enmax bill works well) and proof of age (birth certificate) to info@wolverineshockey.ca to complete your registration.

- PLAYERS TRANSFERING FROM ANOTHER HOCKEY ASSOCIATION: Players transferring to the Wolverines from another hockey association will need to have the players Hockey Canada Profile transferred over to the Wolverines before you can register with us. Send the following documents to info@wolverineshockey.ca to request the transfer:
 - 1) Completed Parent Declaration Form: PARENT DECLARATION FORM
 - 2) THREE proofs of residency (accepted forms are listed on page 2 of the parent declaration)
 - 3) Proof of players age (birth certificate, passport or health care card)
- JUNIOR WOLVERINES: Wolverines Hockey is once again offering our Junior Wolverines program this season. Junior Wolverines is a fun program for 3 & 4 year olds who are learning to move and skate with hockey equipment. Click here for more info: <u>JUNIOR WOLVERINES</u>
- HOUSE LEAGUE HOCKEY: The Wolverines Hockey Club will be hosting House League teams in the U9 & U11 age categories. House League is a great opportunity for players interested in playing on a fixed schedule, with less travel and less financial commitment. - WHC CONDITIONING CAMPS: The Wolverines Hockey Club will once again be running conditioning camps for players in the U9 to U18 age categories at a cost of \$250 per player. Sessions will be held August 26 – 30, 2024 at the Acadia Rec Complex. Times are as follows:

The on-ice sessions will be run by qualified and experienced instructors. We also require 4 volunteer coaches to assist with on ice drills per session. If you are interested in volunteering to coach, you will be able to sign up when you register your player for the camp. <u>Register soon – space is limited!!</u>

COACHING: If you are interested in coaching (as a head coach, assistant coach or goalie coach) for the 2024/2025 season, you must complete the online coaching application here: <u>https://go.teamsnap.com/forms/433737</u>

To coach in Wolverines Hockey Club, coaches must meet the coaching certification requirements. Information regarding coaching requirements can be found here: <u>COACH CERTIFICATION</u> <u>REQUIREMENTS</u>

Reimbursement of coach courses is based on the team's need for reaching the minimum certification required by Hockey Calgary. Once you have completed the course, and have been placed on a team roster, submit a copy of your receipt and proof of attendance to <u>info@wolverineshockey.ca</u>.

All coaches must complete the following prior to the start of the season:

- The on-line Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders course (NOTE: this is a separate course from the Respect in Sport for Parents course): <u>Course Link</u>. The cost is reimbursable on paid receipts and proof of completion being submitted to <u>info@wolverineshockey.ca</u>. This certification must be renewed every 4 years.
- 2. Police Information Check (Criminal Record Search) through the Calgary Police Service. Police Information Checks require renewal every 3 years.
 - Don't have a PIC or yours is expired? Email <u>info@wolverineshockey.ca</u> for instructions on obtaining a new one.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- > **<u>PHOTOS</u>**: Photo night will be scheduled in the fall after teams are determined.
- TEAM SELECTION PROCESS: Evaluations will be scheduled in September. You can expect an email to tell you your child's first ice time sometime after Labour Day. The evaluation process is completed in accordance with Wolverines Hockey Evaluation Manual. The Evaluation Manual can be found on our website here - WHC Evaluation Manual

PLAYERS ARE EXPECTED TO ATTEND ALL WHC TEAM SELECTION ICE TIMES.

- U7 CATEGORY: U7 teams will have ice times on both Saturday and Sunday mornings. They will not be assigned weekday ice. The U7 level is an introduction to hockey, where fun and skating skills are stressed. U7 teams utilize "Home Ice" and do not have a formal schedule of actual games. - U9 CATEGORY: All teams will be seeded in this category and will participate as teams in the Hockey Calgary U9 Development League. The city is divided into North and South divisions to ease the travel burden on these younger players. U9 teams may not play league games against North teams; however, the teams may play team-arranged exhibition games. All U9 games are played on ½ ice.
- REFEREES: Referee clinics are available for anyone interested in wearing the stripes. This is open to anyone aged 13 and older (as of Dec 31, 2024). WHC currently subsidizes WHC Referees \$45.00 of the Referee Clinic costs, you may submit your receipt and proof of course completion to info@wolverineshockey.ca for reimbursement.
